HELP MAKE YOUR SCHOOL ZONE SAFER

School zone traffic often causes safety concerns for parents, their children and the community. It is important that kids learn proper pedestrian practices at a young age and take safe routes to school. The AAA School Safety Patrol program aims to help schools gain control of their school zones by allowing students to take a leadership role in promoting a safer community.

HOW IT WORKS

A Principal or a Vice-Principal must register for the AAA School Safety Patrol program on their school's behalf. A school must have a designated school administrator or teacher responsible for implementing and supervising the program. In some cases, certain tasks may be delegated to and assisted by adult volunteers, including parents. All student Patrollers must participate in a safety patrol training session and wear patroller equipment when on duty. Patrollers are positioned curbside rather than on the roadway and never walk out into the road or direct traffic. An adult must be present during patrol.
